Annual Lund, 2020-2021

You recently received a letter announcing our Annual Fund and upcoming Phone-A-Thon (October 27-28). Our students will be contacting you one of these two nights and I pray you will consider giving and/or pledging a gift to enable us to begin and finish the roof repair before May 2021. This year our annual fund will be focused on the Gym Roof repair that needs to be accomplished before we begin our Phase II of the Capital Campaign --- the gym restroom renovation. The restroom renovation is scheduled to be accomplished over the May thru mid-August of 2021.


We have 247 families represented at the Main Campus and 32 families represented at the Columbia Campus. The analysis below provides an order of magnitude of the impact of each dollar received for this project – and any additional projects. We have collected over \$6,000 from current Board members along with a few past Board members already:



Just think of what we could accomplish if each family were able to contribute \$50 a month for 4 months. Two Chick-Fil-A nights out for a family of four is right around \$45. Remember, Matthew 6:19-21: "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal, but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."




